Nationally-recognized authors Douglas Tallamy and William Cullina, as well as, local experts spoke on topics related to native habitat preservation, ecological landscape design and wild edibles.



...replant the Prosperity Garden; a community garden at Project Native that offers space for community members to grow their own organic vegetables and fruits.



...restore additional wetlands to their more natural state. In 2009 we completed a 7 acres restoration at Kamposoa Bog.
